

**MEETING MINUTES  
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11  
MARCH 8, 2005**

On March 8, 2005, Chairman Rob Haney called the Republican Legislative District 11 meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-American Italian Club, 7509 N. 12<sup>th</sup> St., Phoenix, AZ.

The invocation was given by Sister Carrie. The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America was led by Rev. Wes Darby.

Chairman Haney introduced guests, elected representatives and newly appointed precinct committeemen.

Meeting minutes for February 8, 2005, were approved as distributed.

Chairman Haney introduced Gene Reed, Bylaws Chairman. Mr. Reed, as instructed by the Bylaws Committee, moved for the adoption of the proposed Republican Legislative District 11 Bylaws. The proposed bylaws were adopted at this meeting with the following amendment: ARTICLE V – Organization, Section F, Para. 1. Number of Delegates and Alternates. District Delegates to the State/Congressional District Quadrennial Convention are elected at the Legislative District level and only from among the District 11 Precinct Committeemen and other (the word “interested” was removed) Registered Republicans from District 11. The motion to remove the word “interested” was made by Bob Lynch and seconded by John Acer. Chairman Haney and Bylaws Chairman Reed thanked Jerry Davis and Tom Smith for serving on the Bylaws Committee.

Don Hesselbrock, Registration Chairman, said registration forms are available and asked for volunteers to help with the Registration Committee. Carolyn Berta has precinct walking lists available.

Rep. Steve Tully and Rep. John Allen each spoke on the proposed state budget.

John Acer, Program Chairman, introduced The Honorable Barbara Blewster, President, Arizona Republican Assembly. Mrs. Blewster spoke about the formation and principles of the conservative organization. Mr. Acer then introduced Bill Blewster who spoke on the following trade agreements: Free Trade of the Americas (FTAA), Central American Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA), and North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). These agreements would jeopardize the constitution, sovereignty and freedoms of the United States, erase our borders, and move our country into a New World Order. Citizens should contact our national representatives and demand these trade agreements not be approved.

George Teegarden gave the following treasurer's report: Bal end of Feb, \$376.96; Feb club expenses (mailing bylaws), \$40.00; Mar meeting income, 19 dinners (\$10), \$190.00, cost 25 dinners (\$7.50), -\$187.50, gratuity, -\$25, net dinners -\$22.50; 50/50 drawing \$76.00; 1100 Club membes, \$31.00; total income \$84.50; Mar bank bal, \$421.46.
