

MEETING MINUTES  
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11  
AUGUST 9, 2005

On August 9, 2005, Chairman Rob Haney called the Republican Legislative District 11 meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-American Italian Club, 7509 N. 12<sup>th</sup> St., Phoenix, AZ.

The invocation was given by Rep. John Allen. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Enoch Carson.

Chairman Haney introduced elected officials, guests and new Precinct Committeemen (PC's).

Chairman Haney reported the following: (1) State Chairman Salmon said at the State Executive Meeting held in Prescott on July 23, 2005, the state has a new computer system and a new AZGOP.ORG web site will be forthcoming; (2) Don Goldwater announced his candidacy for governor; (3) State Republican Chaplin Jon McHatton asked each Legislative District to appoint a chaplin – Rev. Wes Darby will be LD/11's chaplin; (4) Secret Service was called into the westside Republican Office because of telephone threats; (5) PC training will occur on two different days in October and November; (6) LD/11's newsletter will include Parliamentary Notes; (7) PC attendance at the July meeting was 64 – quorum was 60; Carolyn Berta has new precinct walking lists; and (8) LD/11 received \$22.00 from the State Party for submitting 22 new voter registration forms.

Treasurer Teegarden reported 29 dinners were sold and 63 PCs and 2 guests were in attendance at the August 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Treasurer's Report will be on the web site.

Meeting minutes for the July 12<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as printed.

Chairman Haney gave the following MCRC Executive Guidance Committee Meeting report: (1) a State sponsored Summer Beach Party will be held August 16<sup>th</sup> at the Phoenix Airport Marriott; (2) Fred Taylor spoke of illegal alien gangs in Arizona and that 70% of the drugs entering the U.S. come through Arizona; and (3) Maricopa County will hold its Mandatory Meeting on January 14<sup>th</sup> at the Ft. McDowell Radisson Resort.

Registration Chairman Hesselbrock said new voter registration forms are now available. Rep. Steve Tully and Rep. John Allen spoke briefly on the State Legislature's plans for the next session.

First Vice-Chairman Acer introduced guest speaker Randy Graf, candidate for U.S. Congress in Congressional District 8. Mr. Graf was presented with the Ben Franklin Award. Mr. Graf spoke on his position regarding the illegal alien situation in Arizona.

First Vice-Chairman of Maricopa County, Marne Haney, spoke on stem cell research. Mrs. Haney provided literature on this subject.
