

**MEETING MINUTES
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 11
MARCH 13, 2007**

Chairman Rob Haney called the March 13th meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona American-Italian Club, 7509 N. 12th St., Phoenix, AZ.

The Invocation was given by Mr. John Acer. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Mr. Tom Husband.

Chairman Haney introduced elected officials and guests.

Sen. Barbara Leff discussed her bill concerning computer child pornography. This bill would help protect individuals from prosecution by the county attorney who unintentionally, and evidence is provided, have child pornography on their computer.

First Vice-Chairman Haney introduced Sen. Karen Johnson who spoke on the North American Union (NAU) being established with Mexico and Canada, along the same lines as the European Union. If this happens it would mean an eventual end to the U.S. Constitution as our ruling document and replaced with a new North American Government. This is happening in Europe today. The effort for the NAU began on March 23, 2005, after a summit, held in Waco, TX It was attended by President Bush, Mexican President Vicente Fox, and (then) Canadian Prime Minister Paul Martin. The three leaders announced the signing of an agreement to create common policies concerning various economic and security areas among the three nations. For official deniability, the term "North American Union" is not being used. Instead, the agreement officially authorized 20 tri-national "working groups" to establish the "Security and Prosperity Partnership (SPP). The trilateral agreement, signed as a joint declaration, has not been submitted to Congress for review. There is no congressional oversight.

Andy Kunasek, County Board of Supervisors, spoke on the role of county paid lobbyists and the number of hours they expend.

Chairman Haney announced a quorum was present with 61 PCs. The February 13th meeting minutes were approved as presented. The Treasurer's Report is posted on LD/11/s website. The Maricopa County Fair will be held April 11-15. Volunteers are needed. Admission and parking is free. Marne Haney is LD/11's county Function Activities Coordinator.
