Chairman Haney called the January 8th meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-Italian Club, 7509 N. 12th St., Phoenix, AZ.

The Invocation was given by Pastor Wes Darby. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States was led by Sean McCaffrey.

Representative Driggs said he fought against the 2007 budget. He asked for voters to talk with himself and Senator Leff concerning legislative bills and budget. Both Senator Leff and himself received D's from the Goldwater Institute.

Guest speaker Sheriff Joe Arpaio spoke on what his office is doing concerning illegal aliens. One hundred sixty officers have received five weeks training to enforce federal and state immigration laws.
