

MEETING MINUTES
REPUBLICAN LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT I I
SEPTEMBER 9, 2008

Chairman Rob Haney called LD/11's September 9 meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Arizona-Italian Club, 7509 N. 12th St., Phoenix, AZ.

The Invocation was given by Bruce Ash. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Pat Todd.

Chairman Haney introduced elected officials, candidates, and guests.

Chairman Haney introduced Bruce Ash, Arizona's Republican National Committeeman. He spoke on the Republican National Convention's Rules Committee, Platform Committee, and the nomination of Governor Sarah Palin as the Republican Vice-Presidential candidate.

Chairman Haney introduced Randy Pullen, State Chairman. Mr. Pullen said the convention produced a grassroots platform. After the national convention, Arizona received a 20% bump in support of the McCain-Palin ticket over the Obama-Biden ticket. In general, 92% of Republicans polled said they will vote for McCain and 88% of Democrats polled said they will vote for Obama. Mr. Pullen is negotiating with the McCain team and the RNC for campaign funds in Arizona.

Sen. Barbara Leff said the Democrat Party is targeting both the Senate and Representative seats in LD/11. Sen. Barbara Leff, Rep. Adam Driggs, and House candidate Jon Altmann asked for PC support in getting elected.

Chairman Haney announced an election for five members to serve on LD/11's Nominating Committee will be held at the October 14th district meeting. Nominations will come from the floor. This committee runs the election for LD/11's Reorganization Meeting to be held Tuesday, November 25, 2008. Executive Officers and State Committeemen will be elected.

Meeting minutes for May 13, 2008; June 10, 2008; July 8, 2008; and August 12, 2008 were approved as presented.

The Honorable Debra Pearson asked for help with fundraisers to raise money for her election to the Maricopa County Community College District 3 position.
